\*AFFIRMATION OF FAITH ~ Adapted from the Confession of 1967

**God's sovereign love is a mystery beyond the reach of human mind. The power of God's love in Christ to transform the world shows that Christ, the Redeemer, is Lord, one with God the Creator who made all things to serve the purpose of his love.**
